PETER GREEN

In the Name of God Amen: I Peter Green of the State of South Carolina: Abbeville County being in a low State of health but of sound mind and disposing memory and calling to mind that it is appointed for all men once to die and being desirous of settling my worldly affairs before my departure do make and constitute this my last will and Testament-- first my will and desire it that my body after my decease be decently buried in a christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter Named & as to my Wordly Estate after the payment of all my Just debts I give and bequeath in the Following manner(Viz) I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Bell one shilling in addition to what I have already give unto her. I give and bequeath unto my son William Green one shilling in addition to what I have already given unto him Item I give and bequeath unto Daughter Martha Moore one shilling in addition to what I have already given unto her Item I give and bequeath unto my Two sons Philemon Green and Sion Green thw whole of the following personal property to be equally and fairly dividedbetween them ( that is to say) four negroes Sukey, Lucy, Abram and Rose, one waggon and gears three horses about sixty head of hogs and all the debts due unto me at my decease Item I give and bequeath unto my son Sion Green in addition to the above one good Feather Bed and furniture and Twenty Barrels of Corn-- Item I giveand bequeath unto my daughter Rebeceah Eddins A negro woman Milley and two Feather Beds already in her possion to herand the heirs of her body forever-- And whereas it ismy will and desire to make provision for the support of mybeloved wife Thamar and two children now living with me Polly Beal and Sarah Beal and being desirous that my son Philemon Green should have the care of them I give and bequeath unto my said son Philemon

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Sion Green in addition to the

Corn-- Item I giveand bequeath unto my daughter Rebeceah Eddins  
A negro woman Milley and two Feather Beds already in her possion  
to herand the heirs of her body forever-- And whereas it ismy will  
and desire to make provision for the support of mybeloved wife  
Thamar and two children now living with me Polly Beal and Sarah  
Beal and being desirous that my son Philemon Green should have  
the care of them I give and bequeath unto my said son Philemon  
Green in addition to what I have already given unto him for the  
purpose of enabling of him to support my wife her life time and  
to raise the aforesaid two girls Polley Beal and Sarah Beal, the  
Tract of land whereon I now live containing one hundred and fifty  
acres with the whole of the remaining part of household furniture  
and the whole of the remaining part of corn and fodder not already  
disposed of--- and lastlyI do appoint Philemon Green my  
Executor
