PETER ROGER

In the presence of Amen. I Peter Roger of Abbeville County  
 Township Abbeville County Planter being sick and weak of  
 body, but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto  
 God; calling unto mind the mortality of my body, & knowing  
 that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and  
 ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say.-  
 principally & first of all, I give & recommand- my Soul in-  
 to the hand of God that gave it, and my body I recommand  
 to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian Manner: not  
 doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the  
 same again by the mighty Power of God. And as touching Such  
 wordly State wherewith it as pleased God to Bless me in this  
 life, I give, Demise, Dispose of the same in the following  
 manner & form. I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife Anna-  
 Berreaud the third of all my personal State as it  
 is allowed to her by the laws of the Country and the use of  
 all my personal & real State during her- widowhood; and after  
 her Death or when my childern comes of age, if in case my said  
 Wife Anna Beraud should mary again, my children Shall divide  
 equally my said State as well the real as the personal: and  
 I likewise name & Constitute & ordain for Executrix of this  
 my last will & Testament my said beloved wife Anna Beraud;  
 and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke, and, disannul all  
 & every other former--Testaments wills, Legaces bequeaths and  
 Executor by me in anywise before named, ratifying and confirm-  
 ing this, and no other to be my last will and Testament, In
