And as touching Such wordly State wherewith it as pleased God to Bless me in this life, I give, Demise, Dispose of the same in the following manner & form. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Anna-Berreaud the third of all my personal State as it is allowed to her by the laws of the Country and the use of all my personal & real State Dureing her- widowhood; and after her Death or when my childern comes of age, if in case my said Wife Anna Beraud should mary again, my children Shall divide equally my said State as well the real as the Personal: and I likewise name & Constitute & ordain for Executrix of this my last will & Testament my said beloved wife Anna Beraud; and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke, and, disannul &every other former -- Testaments wills, Legaces bequeaths and Executor by me in anywise before named, ratifying and confirming this, and no other to be my last will and Testament, Wittness whereof, I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this ninth day of November in the uear of our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred & eighty-nine----Abbeville County Wills 1787-1815
