and ordain this my last will and testament, Revoking and
disanuling all others- First, I do Recommend my Soul to
God and my body to the grave the Tomb where all living is
to be Buried in a Christian manner at the Direction of my
Executors-----

Secondly, I give unto my two Sons Benjamin & Moris Mitchell
all my tract of land to be Equally Divided between them,
Except the plantation part ~~where I have Rascies~~ I give unto
my wife Rebecca Mitchell During her Widowhood, and if she
marries the land to be rented out and the income thereof to
be divid between my two Sons and Daughter till ye come of
age Thirdly, I give unto m Daughter Polly Hail Mitchell
three Hundred Dollars which Benjamin and Moris my two Sons
is to pay her for her part of the land one Hundred and fifty
Each, the first payment to be made when she comes to be
twenty-five years of age fifty Dollars;; Each of my Sons to
Pay to to my Daughter Polly Hail and fifty Dollars yearly
to be paid by Each of my Sons till the three hundred Dol-
lars is paid to my Daughter Polly Hail, and if she cannot
pay it in the time that is before mentioned they are not to
be Distrust for the money-

Fourthly, I give unto my three Children Benjamin Moris and
Polly Hail three Negroes, Jenny Gaby and Aaron and their in-
crease to be Equally Divided between them when they come of
age,-

come of age the before mentioned property is to be Equally
Divided between the two left if two Should Expire before they
come of age I give the whole of the before mentioned property
to the one left if all my three Children Should Expire before
they come of age;; I give the whole of the before mentioned
property to my wife Rebeka Mitchell-----

Sixthly " The tobacco cotten and other articles Such as my Executors thinks proper I leave in their hands to Satisfy a ll lawfull Demand that is against me, and if there is not enough to Satisfy The Demands there is against me part of the land that I left to my Children Such as my Executors thinks can be best ~~Spared~~ must be sold to Satisfy the balance of my Debts.

Seventhly, all the Stock, household furniture and plantations tools I give for the use of the Plantation and when my Children comes of age then to be divided amongst them as my Executors sees proper
