Item I give & bequeath to my Daughter Margaret Reid Wife of Hugh Reid of the District aforem'd Plantermy Negroe dench nam'd Senna, with the Increase of the B'd Negroe Wench, Item I give and bequeath to my Sen Samuel Reid Three head of Horfes, four Cows & Calves which he formerly Received, and also a Negro Fellew Man A dam, and Likewise whatkeney I dave to purchase the Negro Wendh Kett, And also the Plantation that he now lives on which I Purphased from Jeseph Salvadore for him Item I give and beq weath to my son Alexa nder Reid Four Negros, a Negore fellow Nam'd Munnuth Philip his Wifes negree Bey Nam'd Tem , a Nagro Wench Ham'd Prue, Item I give and bequeath to my sen Joseph Reid Feur Megroes, a Fellew Nam'd Brimifs, a Fellew Nam'd Bofon a Hegree Bey, Mamed Ifaac a Negre Wench, Hamed Hannah.Moreever it is my will that if the a beve nam'd Negre wench Philifs Should ha ve any more Children that they shall be Divided Equaly between my Sens Alex: and Jefeph. And Lartly it is my Will that the Pla ntation Lying on the Waters of the Hen Goope Containing Three Bundred & Twenty A order is my last dift. Which I give & beq bequeath to my son Samuel, and I do hereby Appoint / He j ' John Bowie Hagr. Capt: High Wardlaw, & Capt: William Bufkins, Rugr of the Diffriet aformatid ; to be quardians or Overfeers, of this my Last will & Tellament, in cafe any Dispute or Controversy should happen amount my Sons that it may beleft to their determination size that what is to be Divided that they may see it Equitably done; IN witness whereof the sid George have hereunte set his hand and seal this Twenty third Day of
