one thousand Seven hundred & ninety-three

I Richard Caine being weak in body but of perfect mind & memory
and calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it
is appointed for all men once to die I do constitute appoint &
ordain this to be my last will & testament and first of all I
give & bequeath my Soul to God how gave it not doubting but I
shall receive the Same againe at the general Resurrection my body I
allow to be decently entered at the discretion of my Executors
and as touching what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bless me
with I give and bequeath in the following manner

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary the one half
of all my estate Real & personal including a negro boy named Jes

Item I give unto my beloved daughter - Sara Caine fourteen
hundred pounds of tobacco excepting one scarlet clock

I give & bequeath unto beloved daughter Elisabeth Bradley Botherys
Caine one bay geldyn named Starling & one cow & calf & unto my
beloved son James Caine one soral mare of fore years old with his
sadel bridel & gun

& all the best of my estate after my lawfull debt being paid to
fall to my beloved wife Mary hence I appoint my hole and Executor
the above publish & pronounce to be my last wil & testament
as witness my hand Saill the day & date above writen
