I Richard Lewallen of the County of Abbeville and State of South Carolina, knowing the uncertainty of human life, and considering it a duty to arrange my worldly affairs before I depart this life do make this my last Will & ~~Testament~~ I do give & bequeath to my dear Wife Lettuce forever the following articles of property Viz Two Negro fellows named Molow and Jacob-- The one half of the tract of Land whereon I now live lyoin on Savannah River-- One Horse and that part of the sheep, Hogs, and Cattle, which was left my wife by her Father. likewise one Bed & furniture together with all the property I may possess at my decease except Four dollars, two of which I give to my Sister Lettuce Lew allen and the other two to my Brother Mays Lewallen
