In the Name of God Amen--

I Rich Pollard of abbeville District being in perfect
Health and of perfect memory but willing to
bind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is ap-
pointed fro all men to die I do make ordain & constitute
this my last will and Testament--- That is principally
and first of all I recommend my Soul unto the hands of
Almighty God that gave it and my Body to the earth to be
Burried in a cristian like manner at the discretion of my
Trustees herein after mentioned--- And as touching such
worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless me with,
I dispense in the following manner After all my Lawfull
Debts are paid I lend to my Dear Wife the Whole of my
Property real and personal until many of my Children
comes of age or Marries and at that time the whole of my
Property is to be Valued and laid out in lots and My
wife reserving one third of s Property which I lend her
during her natural life and at her Decease it is to re-
turn to my Surviveng Children or there Lawfull Heirs, the
ballance of my Property belong to my Children is to be
equally divided among them all and those of my Children
that are under age the property belonging to them
~~may be sold by my executors~~ may be hired out or as my Execut-
ors may think most advantagous and it is my Will that my
Daughter Tamela's Portion of land should be made up in
Negro Property and the Land to be Divided among my three
Son to wit, Austin Isaac and Rich Pollard and Should
any of my above mentioned Children die without lawful

Having a perfect memory- but willing to bind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die I ordain & constitute this my last will and Testament--- That is principally and first of all I recommend my Soul unto the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my Body to the earth to be Buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Trustees herein after mentioned--- and as touching such worldly Estate as it has pleased God to bless me with, I dispose of in the following manner After all my Legal Debts are paid- I lend to my Dear Wife the Whole of my Property real and personal untile many of my Children comes of age or Marries and at that time the whole of my Property is to be Valued and laid out in lots and My wife reserving one third of s Property which I lend her during her natural life and at her Decease it is to return to my Surviving Children or there Lawfull Heirs, the balance of my Property belong to my Children is to be equally divided among them all and those of my Children that are under age the property belonging to them may be hired out or as my Executors may think most advantagous and it is my Will that my Daughter Tamela's Portion of land should be made up in Negro Property and the Land to be Divided among my three Son to wit, Austin Isaac and Rich Pollard and Should any of my above mentioned Children die without lawfull Issue the property they held shall return to the surviving Children and lastly I do appoint my Loving wife Sary Pollard my Executrix and John Walls and Wm. Pollard Executors and my Son Austin Pollard as Soon as my above mentioned Trustee shall think him capable
