ROBERT BOND

In the name of God Amen the fifth day of Feb 1791 I Robert Bond  
of the State of South Carolina Abbeville County being in A low  
State of health but of good and sound memory thanks be to Almighty  
God and calling to remembrance the uncertain estate of this trans-  
itory life and that all flesh must yeald to death when it Shall  
please god to Call do make Constitute ordain and declare this my  
last will and testament in manner and form following Revoking and  
a nulling by these presents all and Every testament and testaments  
will and wills here to fore by me made and declared either by word  
or writing and this is to be taken only for my last will and  
testament and none other and first being peasant and Sorry from  
my heart for my Sins past meet humbly desiring forgiveness for the  
Same I ~~humble~~ commit my Soul unto Almighty god my Savior and  
redemer in whom and by the merits of Jesus Christ I trust and  
believe Assuredly to be Saved and to have full remission and  
forgiveness of all my Sins and that my Soul with my body at a  
general day of the Resurrection Shall rise again with joy and  
through the merits of Christ's death and passion possess and inherit  
the kingdom of heaven prepared for his Elect and Chosen And my  
body to be buried in Such a place where it Shall please my Executors  
here after named to appoint And now for the Setling of my temporal  
estate and Such goods and Chattels and debts as it hath pleased  
god far Above my deserts to bestow upon me I Do order give and  
dispose the Same in manner & form following that is to say first  
I will that all these debts that I owe in right and Contience  
to Any manner of person or persons whatsoever Shall be well and  
truly Contented and paid or ordained to be paid within Convenient  
time after my decease by my Executors hear after named and first  
I give and bequeath to my loving and affectionate wife her living  
of my plantation while while She livith and the third of all  
movable property and Secondly I give this plantation I now live  
on to my Son Roberts oldest Son and to Robert I give all the  
plantation tools and the third of all movable property thirdly  
I give to my daughter Mary the third of all movable property that  
is in my pfofession at this time and all other lands that I  
possess I leave to my Son Robert but he Shall pay James Campbell

fifty pound Sterling in Cash out of these lands that I possess for  
beside this land that I live on at this time Signed in the presence  
of us
