I will to my son samuel & the rest of my estate (Viz) The above written stock at the decease of my wife to be Eaqually divided with all, their increase only what is used in supporting the family betwixt my two children Mary & Thomas and I do hearby nominate and appoint, my beloved wife Rosanna Clark; and my son Samuel clark my Executrix and Executor of this my last will and testament; & I do hearby disanul all other wills by me made and do nominate and ordain this undnone but this, my last will and Testament in witness wherof I have set my hand this ninteenth of October in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and three
