Seeing that life is uncertain and Death certain to all men I being at this time in my perfect senses and right mind I leave this as my last will and testament with my wife Madrif Williams and my brother Arthur Williams as ex'ors to administer and law fully Dispose of all my afairs according to my will that is first that all lawful Debts be payed in order for which my land of one hundred acres lying in Greenville County shall be sold to pay off my Debts and also that all Debts Due to me be paid for the better Discharging my own Debts and all the rest of my goods I will and bequeath to my wife Madrif Williams during her widowhood or ~~xxx~~ life if She remain a widow if she marry again all my goods shall be sold and Devided among my children and wifes son Isaac Sherodine he is to have and Equal xxx part with my children her third is to her lifetime if she mary again if She remain a widow til Death all my affairs shall at be kept together and at her disese all my affairs shall be dis'osed as above mensioned in this my last will and I do hereby revoke all other wills hertofore made by me witness my hand and seal this Eighth Day of April 1801 and in the twenty fifth year of the independancy of the united States of america
