TANNER MITCHELL

In the Name of God Amen. I Tanner Mitchel (widow) of the State of South Carolina and County of Abbeville being very weak in body but of perfect mind and Memory & Calling to mind the Mortality of my body and knowing there is a time appointed for all men once to die, Do make Ordain and Constitute this my last will & Testament (Viz) First I recommend my Soul to God who gave it me & Secondly my body to the Earth to be buried at the Discretion of Executors, Thirdly as to my Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless mw with I do leave in the Manner & form following (Viz) First I do will & bequeath unto my Sons Solomon & Mason the North Side of My land & unto my Sons John & Morris the South Side to be equally Divided ~~also~~ the plantation Tools I leave to be ~~Divided~~ ~~the above named~~ Sons according to their value, I do also leave unto my Son Solomon One Negro Man Named Sharper & one feather Bed which he has now possission, I do also Give unto my son John One Negro wench Named Cloe. I do also Give unto my Son Robert Two Negroe boys Named Harry & Jim also One bed & furniture-- I do also Give unto my Son Mason One Gegro wench Named Smidy & One Negro Child Named Mary also one Bed & furniture I also give unto my Son Morris One Negro Girl Named Nancee & one bed & furniture I also Give unto my Daughter Rebecca Two Negroes One Named Patt & the other Sineca, One horse & saddle to the value of Twenty pounds, One bed & furniture four head of Cattle formerly her claim, also the loom & Geers I also Give to my Grandson James Griffin One Negro Child Named Tom to remain in the hands of my son John Untill he comes of age. I also Give Unto my Grandson John Mitchell Son of Thomas Mitchell Twenty pounds to be paid him by my Executors when he arrives at the age of 21 years

(Viz) First I recommend my Soul to God - who gave it me & Secondly my body to the Earth to be buried at the Discretion of ~~my~~ Executors, Thirdly as to my Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with I do leave in the Manner & form following (Viz) First I do will & bequeath unto my Sons Solomon & Mason the North Side of My land & unto my Sons John & Morris the South Side to be equally Divided ~~also~~ the plantation Tools I leave to be ~~Divided~~ ~~among~~ the above ~~named~~ Sons according to their value, I do also leave unto my Son Solomon One Negro Man Named Sharper & one feather Bed which he has now possession, I do also Give unto my son John One Negro wench Named Cloe. I do also Give unto my Son Robert Two Negroe boys Named Harry & Jim also One Bed & furniture-- I do also Give unto my Son Mason One Negro wench Named Smidy & One Negro Child Named Mary also one Bed & furniture I also give unto my Son Morris One Negro Girl Named Nancee & one bed & furniture I also Give unto my Daughter Rebecca Two Negroes One Named Patt & the other Sineca, One horse & saddle to the value of Twenty pounds, One bed & furniture four head of Cattle formerly her claim, also the loom & Geers I also Give to my Grandson James Griffin One Negro Child Named Tom to remain in the hands of my son John Untill he comes of age. I also Give Unto my Grandson John Mitchell Son of Thomas Mitchell Twenty pounds to be paid him by my Executors when he arrives at Twenty one Years of age.

I do will & Bequeath unto my Sons in General my whole Stock of Cattle Exclusive of the Number before Mentioned to be equally Divided ~~among~~ them I also will that my horses, hogs & household furniture (beds Excepted) be sold in order to Defray my Debts, I do Lastly constitute & Appoint my Sons Solomon & John Mitchell & my Good Friend Benjamin Mitchell my Sole Executors to this my last will & Testament revoking & Abolishing all wills whatsoever
