THOMAS TAYLOR

In the name of God amen I Thomas Tayler of the County of Cul-  
 peper--Being Infirm in Body, but in perfect health, do make and  
 ordain this My last will and testament. In Form following: that is  
 To Say, I give and Recommend my Soul Into the hand of almighty  
 God that gave it, and my Body I Recommend to the Earth to be De-  
 cently Interred at the discreftion of my Executioners and touch-  
 ing Such worldly Estate which it hath pleased God to Blefs me with  
 I will and Bequeath in the following Manner and form-----  
 I Bequeath to Johannah Taylor my dearly Beloved wife two negroe  
 Girls Lidda and Cate, and all other things of my Estate her Life  
 or So long as She Contentes a widow, after my just debts are paid,  
 after her Death an Widowhood I desire it may be divide. Equally  
 amongst all my Children, (By Johannah) I likewise Constitute make and ordain  
 william Miles and John Tayler my Executioners. and I do hereby  
 utterly Disallow, Revoke and disannul all and every other former  
 Testaments and wills by me in any way before named willed and  
 bequeathed, Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my  
 last will and Testament. In witness whereof, I have hereunto  
 Set my hand and Seal. December 2, In the year of our Lord 1787--
