In the Name of God Amen - I Thomas M<sup>c</sup>Kee of Abiville County Planter, being weak in Body, but of sound Mind and Memory (blessed be God) do this Twentieth day of October, in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninty Six, Make and publish this my last will and Testament, in Manner following (that is to say) Imprimis, I give to my Loving Wife Martha her Bed and her Wheel and peassable possession the House and plantation I now Live on, Dureing her Widowhood, with the disposal of all the Tableing Furniture, and a Horse Creature to ride when she thinks Nessasary, Item, I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Jean, ~~one~~ Two cows a Bed and Furniture which she has now in possession Item, I give ~~and~~ to my Sons Thomas and William and John and James all my possession of Lands Containing Four Hundred Acres, to be Equally divided amongst them as the shall agree, only my son Thomas, to have the House, I now live in, with the Hundred Acres around it if he Chuses it rather, Item I leave and direct all of my Stock of Horses and Cow Cattle to be Equally Divided amongst my Wife and Unmarried Children, my Wife to have a Choise of a Number as She may think sufficient for her Support, I Include Sheep and Hogs Likewise in the Stock, And I Constitute and Appoint my Friends Samuel Reed and Robert Gilmore to be my Executors of this my Will to take care and see the same performed, according to my true Intent and Meaning.
