I also Give to my Son James one Dollar, I also Give to my Daughter Joannan Roberts one Dollar--- and the Remaining part of my Property I

Dilliph for their use & Benifit & I Likewise Empower my Exor<sup>s</sup> to

make Rites or titles for the Land that I have Sold--- if I should
