Thanks be to God for ~~the~~ Same & Calling to Mind my mortality, do make & Ordain this my last Will & testament.

Imprimis I positively will and order that all my Just debts be paid

I give and bequeath unto Margaret my beloved wife my best bed & furniture, together with all my household furniture, her bible, & Psalm book, Check Red & her Spinning wheel, And her Choice of any two Cows & two Calves. ~~she~~ have. I also Bequeath h r one young mare Named Kate; Six Geese, two Bee hives; the Plantation & tools be longing to it During her widowhood; or Life and at the Execution of any of these the Land to be Sold, or Equally devided among my three Sons and the Plantation, tools, also as my Exe-  
cutors Shall See Cause or think most Beneficial--I also Bequeath unto her two Ewes, her Saddle & Bridle with all her Wearing Apperal--

I Give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary a Pocket Bible, the next best bed & furniture also her Mothers wheel, my Loom & tacklings And hereby Order that all her mothers Cloths be Equally Divided by her Step mother & Christian Robertson, between her & her Sister Agnes--I give & Bequeath unto my son James a Bible, my wearing Apperal, & my old Saddle. I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Agnes one feather Bed & furniture--I Give & Bequeath Unto my Step son <sup>m</sup> W. Thompson one heifer three Years Old--And I hereby Order that the total Remainder of my Property be Sold Abbeville County Wills 4787-1815

I Give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary a Pocket Bible, the next best bed & furniture also her Mothers wheel, my Loom & tacklings And hereby Order that all her mothers Cloths be Equally Divided by her Step mother & Christian Robertson, between her & her Sister Agnes--I give & Bequeath unto my son James a Bible, my wearing Apperal, & my old Saddle ' give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Agnes one feather Bed & furniture--I Give & Bequeath Unto my Step son <sup>m</sup> W. Thompson one heifer three Years Old--And I hereby Order that the total Remainder of my Property be Sold & the Monies arising be Equally Devided at the Discretion of my Executors among my Children--and if it should so happen that any of my Children die before they Come to the years of maturity I allow what I have bequeathed to them be Equally Devided among my Surviving Children--I hereby Constitute & Appoint my loving wife Margaret & my trusty friends James Cochran & Benjamin Clarke my Only & Sole Executors of this my last will & Testament Ratifying And Confirming
