WILLIS BREAZEALE

In the name of God Amen, I Willis Breazeale Senf of the State of South Carolina in the County of Abbeville Being in perfect helth of body and of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God, Cawlling unto Mind the mortallity of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die to make and ordain This my last will and Testament that is to say Principally and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul Into the hand of almighty God that gave it and my body I Recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the descretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive The same by the mighty power of god And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to blesse in this life I give descease and dispose of the same in the following manner and form First I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah the sum of twenty five pounds Sterling money during her widowhood and prudent behaviour as also my Negrow girl to wait upon her During her prudent behaviour the negroes name is Cissoe Also my beloved ~~wife~~ Misha Breazeale I give and bequeath my Negrow woman Named Cate as also her Daughter Named Cissoe by him and the Heirs of his beddy freely to be possessed and enjoyed forever But if the said Misha Breazeale should decease leaving no such heir as above mentioned that then the Said Negrows Shall Revert to and belong properly to Benjamin Frankling Breazeale my son, But if said Benjamin Frankling Breazeale Should Decease before he shall have heirs or heirs lawfully begotten that then the fore Named Negrow Shall Revert to and belong to Kinsmen Breazeale and A rohabald Breazeale and their heirs lawfully betotten also to my beloved Son Benjamine Frankling Breazeale I give and bequeath the plantation or tract of land were on I now dwel Containing two hundred acres By him and his heirs

This my last will and testament made as to day this day  
and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul Into the hand of  
almighty god that gave it and my body I Recommend to the Earth  
to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the descretion of my  
Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I

his body freely to be possessed and enjoyed forever But if the  
said Elisha Breazeale should decease leaving no such heir as  
above mentioned that then the Said Negrows Shall Revert to and  
belong properly to Benjamin Frankling Breazeale my son. But if  
said Benjamin Frankling Breazeale Should Decease before he shall  
have heirs or heirs lawfully begotten that then the fore Named  
Negrow Shall Revert to and belong to Kinsman Breazeale and  
Archibald Breazeale and their heirs lawfully begotten Also to my  
beloved Son Benjamine Frankling Braxeale I give and bequeath  
the plantation or tract of land were on I now dwel Containing  
two hundred acres By him and his heirs freely to possed that is  
to say the heirs of his body lawfully begotten but if he Decease  
without an heir lawfully begotten that then Said land shall  
Revert unto his younger brothers kinsman Breazeale and Archibald  
Breazeale with all and singuler the houses orchards fencing  
waters and water courses Also to my three Sons Drury Willis and  
Elijah Breazeale I give to Each one of them the Sum of one  
Shilling Sterling if the same Shall be lawfully demanded as also

Each one of the the sum of one shilling Sterling if the same  
shall be lawfully demanded the Residue and Remainder of my Estate  
if any there should be after my lawful Debts is paid I give and  
bequeath to my sons George Washington Benjamin Franklin  
Reuben & reubald Breazeale that is to say the Remainder of  
my lands live's Stock house hold furniture plantation Tools  
Books and book debts Bonds bills notes of hand moneys &c to be  
equally Divided amongst them Also to my old Negrow woman Named  
Newcorer I give and bequeath her freedom to be no longer a  
servent after my deceas also my will is that my Executors do not  
let said old Negrow Suffer Either For food or Rement whilst my  
Estate is Sufficient to Support her also the money bequeathed to  
Sarah My wife if she should Behave imprudenc or keep a disorderly  
house after my deceas is to be Taken from her and Equally  
divided betwenn my four youngest sons by her begotten and I do  
Hereby Constitute make and ordain y Beloved Brothers Drury  
Breazeale Sen<sup>r</sup> and my Son Elisha Breazeale and Sarah Breazeale  
my wife the whole and sole Executors and Executrix of this my
