WILLIS BREAZEALE

In the name of God Amen, I Willis Breazeale Son of the State of South Carolina in the County of Abbeville Being in perfect health of body and of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God, Cawling unto God the mortallity of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die Do make and ordain This my last will and Testament that is to say Principally and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul Into the hand of almighty God that gave it and my body I Recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive The same by the mighty power of god And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form First I give and bequeath to my wife Sarah the sum of twenty five pounds Sterling money during her widowhood and prudent behaviour as also my Negrow girl to wait upon her During her prudent behaviour the negroes name is Cizzoe Also my beloved son Elisha Breazeale I give and bequeath my Negrow woman Named Ca to as also her Daughter Named Cizzoe by him and the heirs of his body freely to be possessed and enjoyed forever But if the said Elisha Breazeale should decease leaving no such heir as above mentioned that then the said Negrows shall Revert to and belong properly to Benjamin Frankling Breazeale my son, But if said Benjamin Frankling Breazeale Should Decease before he shall have heirs or heirs lawfully begotten that then the fore Named Negrow shall Revert to and belong to Kinsman Breazeale and A rehabald Breazeale and their heirs lawfully betotten also to my beloved Son Benjamine Frankling Breazeale I give and bequeath the plantation or tract of land where on I now dwell Containing two hundred acres By him and his heirs freely to possess and

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Archabald Breazeale and their heirs lawfully betotten Also to my
beloved Son Benjamin Frankling Breazeale I give and bequeath
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to say the heirs of his body lawfully begotten but if he Decease
without an heir lawfully betotten that then Said land shall
Rever unto his younger brothers kinsman Breaxeale and Archabald
Breazeale with all and singular the houses orchards fencing
wa rters and water courses Also to my three "ons Drury Willis and
Elijah Brea zeales I give to Each one of them the Sum of one
Shilling Sterling if the same shall be lawfully demanded as also

to my three Daughters Mary Sarah and patty Breazeales I give to
Each one of the the sum of one Shilling Sterling if the same
shall be lawfully demanded the Residue and Remainder of my Estate
if any there should be after my lawful Debts is paid I give and
bequeath to my sons George Washington Benjamin Franklin
Remain A resabale Breazeales that is to say the Remainder of
my lands live's Stock house hold furniture plantation Tooles
Books and book debts Bonds bills notes of hand moneys &c to be
equally Divided amongst them Also to my old Negrow woman Named
Newcorer I give and bequeath her freedom to be no longer a
servent after my decease also my will is that my Executors do not
let said old Negrow Suffer Either For food or Cloament whilst my
Estate is Sufficient to Support her also the money bequeathed to
Sarah My wife if she should Behave imprudent or keep a disorderly
house after my decease is to be Taken from her and Equally
divided between my four youngest sons by her begotten and I do
Hereby Constitute make and ordain y Beloved Brothers Drury
Breazeale Sen^r and my Son Elisha Breazeale and Sarah Breazeale
my wife the whole and sole Executors and Executrix of this my
last will and testament and I do hereby utterly disallow Revoake
and disanull all and Every other former testaments wills, legacies
bequests and Executors or Executrix by me in anywise before named
will and bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this and No
other to be my last will and testament in "itness whereof I have
unto set my hand and seal this Sixth day of November in the
year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and Nintey four
Signed Sealed Published Pronounced and declared By the said
Willis Breazeale Sen^r as his last will And Testament in the
presents of us Who in his presents And in the presents of Each
other have hereunto Subscribed our names
