this life I give Dispose and Dispose of the Same in the follow-
ing Manner and form-----

First I give and Bequeath unto my dearly Beloved Wife Sarrah
that Planta tion or Tract of land that I now live on and all
so all my Personal Estate of Every Quality and Kind Except one
Shilling to William Carmichael Son of Daniel Carmichael De-
ceased Likewise I give and Bequeath Unto Joseph William &
Robert Carmichael (Each one Shilling If demanded) sons of
Joseph Carmichael Senr Deceased it is Likewise my desire
that if my wife Sarrah Should Depart this life before John
Tidwell is become of age that he Should Have his Freedom, I
Do Likewise appoint my Beloved wife Sarah to be my Executrix
of this my Last will and Testament in witness whereof I have
hereonto Set my hand and Seal the year and day above Written.-
