In the Name of God Amen I William Chiles of South Carolina in Abbeville is strict Being old and weak in body but perfect in mind and Memory To make Constitute and Appoint my will This my Last/ and testament in manner and form following to Witt, that my burial be left to the Discretion of My Children and that all my Just Debts be first paid Item, I Do hereby Ratify and Confirm all the Gifts that I have already Giving to my Children which they had in their pos- sion, Item I give and Bequeath to my Son John, part of a Tract of Land of four hundred acres Granted to Patrick Gipson begining at an Ash Corner on a branch running through a tract bounded by, side by land of Reubin Chiles Towne in running to the Old Nine thence agreeable to the original plat Excepting a small part bounded by Reubin Chiles mill Pon, with all that appertains to a tract to him his heirs and assigns for Ever, Also, I give and bequeath to my Son John Seventy acres of Land bounded on a tract Granted to Patrick Gipson as aforesaid, Also bounded on lands formerly held by from thence the aforesd Ash Corner William Smith/ to him and his heirs and assigns for Ever, ~~Also I give and bequeath to my Son Reuben one acre of~~ Land on the old Road adjoining to Reubin Chiles own land to his heirs for Ever, Item I give and Bequeath to my Son William the plantation on tract of land Whereon I now live with all the appurtenance belonging to the same Containing part of severall tracts of land agreeable to a plat made by Abner Perrin Des. Containing by my Survey three Hundred fifty five acres Excepting one acre Bequeath to my Son Reuben, to him and his heirs for Ever I ALSO give and bequeath to my Son William two Negroe to WITT Named Moses Daffenny also one

Bally Tunice And Whereas the Land which I have formerly giving to my Son Thomas is not as Valuable as the Lands giving to Other Sons it is my will and I do Direct that he Shall be paid Thirty pound Sterling out of my Estate when it Shall be Sold as ab [redacted] rocted Over and above his Equall part a & above Kentacione I also give to my Son Thomas one feather Bed and furniture to him and his heirs for Ever And Lastly I do nominate and Appoint my Four Sons Namely Reuben Thomas John & William Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby Revoking all Others Wills heretofore Made by me in Testimony whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this fourth Day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and four
