

In the name of god amen I william martin of the State of South Carolina and County of Abbeville being weak in body but of perfect memory and bearing in mind the mortality of my body ans that it is appointed for all men once to die and after that to come to Judgment I dispose of all my affairs in the form and manner as follows Viz first I bequeath my Soul to god who gave and my body to the dust to be burried in a christen manner in hopes of a glorious reunion to my soul at the resurrection of the Just 2dly I bequeath my Land to to be Eaqualy devided amongst my 4 grandsons Viz William McMurtrey Joseph McMurtrey John McMurtrey & James McMurtrey 3dly I also bequeath to my 4 grand sons above named thirty seven pound Virginia/ ^{money} with ~~the~~ Interest from the year of 1763 untill this present day Lent in money to my Son In Law, Samuel McMurtrey the same to be eaqualy Divided amongst them 4thly I bequeath all my cattle to my granddaughters Sarah Watts and Jenny McMurtrey to be eaqualy divided between them 5thly I bequeath to my daughter Jean all my household furniture that is now about her house all the furniture that my granddaughter ~~Samuel~~ has in her pesesion I bequeath to her 6thly I appoint that my mare and colt be sold and the money to be Eaqualy divided among my grandsons before mentioned likewise all the money in the hands of Thomas Lessly and Thomas Martin ~~xxx~~ I appoint to be Collected and Eaqualy divided amongst my grandsons and all Credits found among my papers to be devided in the same manner my debts to be paid out of said notes and Credits Lastly I Constitute and appoint Samuel Watts and William Lessly Executors of this my Last will and testement in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 25 day of January 1793 in presence of
