personal Estate, and the one third, and the Two beds and furniture after my wife Athaiah Norris death is to be Equally divided among her cChildren. I leave Mr. Walter manning Executor & my wife Athaiah Norris Executrix to my last will and testament etc. herunto I set my hand and Seal this 27 day of October 1803
