I William Woods of the District aforesaid State of South Carolina
~~aware of my own~~ as well as the Mortality of others- & being
now in Health & of sound mind and Memory--Do make & ordain my
Last Will & Testament as herein follows--Viz First it is my
Will & order that after the Expensses of my Funeral upon the
plain & Decent Practice of the county be discharged all my
just Debts be paid according to ~~Said~~ Law----

Secondly To my Beloved Wife or Widow Susana Catharina should
she survive me (which may God grant) I give & leave in Fee-
Simple all my Estate real & Personal to be enjoyed and disposed of
~~as her option & indurment~~ not in the least doubting but she will
act an honest & conscientious Part thereby according to the
best of her judgement---

Thirdly I do hereby revoke and disannul all & every other wills or
will by me heretofore made, if such therebe, in any Respect
whatsoever contravening this one-- And in Testimony of the Same
I do hereunto subscribe my name & affix my seal the date above
& in the 27th year of the Independence of the United States of
America--
