My Dearly beloved Parents and Sister, as possible, in St Michials Church Yard

And What Worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bestow--Upon me, I do hereby leave and Bequeath in Manner and Form following to My most Worthy Friend and best Adviser-----
Doctor John Dela'hove practioner of Physic in the City of Charles Town And State Aforesaid, My whole Estate both real and personal, except A few triffling Legacys which will be hereafter mentioned, as knowing No One so Justly intitled to my Friendship and Gratitude as the Above mentioned Gentleman
in Primis to that Good Gentleman M^r Daniel Bourdeaux I bequeath A Valuable Rose Diamond Ring, set round with twelve Brilliants, To M^{rs} Bourdeaux three Large Table silver spoons and apair of Garnet Snap Earrings, to Miss Eliza Bourdeaux, a little Chagrin Case containing A pair of Chrystal Pendant Earrings, with three Straps to each, a little out of repair, but easily mended, and two Silver Needle Cases, these I hope the family will accept as tokens of Remembrance

To M^{rs} Mathews all My wearing Apparel, two pairs of sheets, two pillow cases, A Silver Papspoon, and six silver tea spoons, not new ones, two Dressing Glafes in Mahogany frames an A Counterpane. But as I have met with the most solid Friendship and disinterested from My very Worthy Friend Doctor John Dela'hove, I hereby name the said Doctor as my sole Executor and Heirs
