29th June the 1789

In the Name of God amen I Robert Yeldell Sen^r of the State of South Carolina Abbeville County Being weak in body but of Sound Memory Blessed be God for the Mercies to me, but Calling to Mind the Mortality of my Body and that it is appointed unto all men once to die I do make and ordain this My Last will and Testament in manner following that is to Say I do Recommend My Soul to the almighty God who gave it me and my body I Recommend to the Earth from whence it was taken to be decently Burried at the Descretion of My Executors hereafter named as to My worldly Estate which God has ben pleased to bestow on me I Do dispose in the way and manner following (Viz). I gave and bequeath unto the Heirs of My Loving son James Yeldell Sen^d one Ewe Lamb to be Deliv^d after My Decease also my Loving Daughter Jean Atkins and her Heirs one shilling Ste^r also I Gave and bequeath unto my Loving daughter Sarah White and her Heirs one Read heifer Marked with a Crop in the Left Ear and Hole in the other Ear to be Delivered after My Dece^d also I Gave and bequeath unto my Grand daughter, Daughter of Joseph Dennis five pounds Sterling money also I Gave and Bequeath unto my Loving Daughter Mary Heir-ten one Shilling Sterling also I Gave and bequeath unto my Lov- ing Son Robert Yeldell one Sorrel mare which I left in his posess- ion I Gave and bequeath unto My Loving son Anthony Yeldell all that Tract of Land Containing Two Hundred acres of Land situate on the Waters of Long Cane on a c^r---Creek called and known by the name of of the Readybranch whereon I now live in Two Differ- ent Tracts to him his heirs and assigns for Ever with all my Plantation Tools and is to find his Mother Sufficient Living Dur- ing her Natural life also I give and bequeath unto my Loving Daughter Phebe Yeldell one horfe of about six or seven Pounds St^r also one side saddle one Read and white spotted heifer also one ewe also I gave and bequeath unto my Loving Grandson Robert Yeldell Twenty Pounds Ster^d money if he shall or does stay with his uncle anthony Yeldell and his grandmother till he shall come
