AARON ALEXANDER

In the Name of God amen I - Aaron Alesander of the state of South Carolina & County of Abbeville Being in a sick and Low Condition of body but of sound Memory and Judgement do Make, Constitute and ordain this my Last will and testament in form following that is to say - I gave and bequeth to my beloved wife the third of all My personal property and- her thirds of the Land while she Lives my wido - I allow all my debts to be paid by selling of Such personal ^{poperty} as my My executors thinks best and I Leave my Land to be equally devided among my Children at the discretion of my executors - and I make Joseph Black & Thomas oiston harris my Executors of this My Last will and testament - I likewis declare my Negro fellow Dave - to be free from slavery and to be at his own disposal hereafter in witness whereof I have sined these presents and sealed them this 19th day of February 1796
