I Ambrose Mason of the State and District aforesaid, calling to mind the uncertainty of life, for the disposal of such property as I may die pofsefsed of, do make and ordain this my last will and testament, revoking all other dispositions thereof heretofore made.

First

I desire that all my just debts be paid, and all the residue of my estate, Lands, Negroes and their future increase, and other personalty, I give and bequeath to Jenny Payne for and during her natural life, and at her death. I give and bequeath all Eaid Estate, Lands, Negroes, and other personalty

And in vindication of myself for the disposition herein made of my Estate, declare it to be in persuance of intentions long since formed, being mainly indebted to the kindnefs and care of those herein provided for the preservation of such property as I have to bequeath, In testimony whereof I have set my hand and Seal this the fourtenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty seven and in the Sixty first Year of American Independence
