And in vindication of myself for the disposition herein made of my Estate, declare it to be in pursuance of intentions long since formed, being mainly indebted to the kindness and care of those herein provided for the preservation of such property as I have to bequeath, In testimony whereof I have set my hand and Seal this the fourteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty seven and in the Sixty first Year of American Independence
