Item 2<sup>nd</sup>. To my son Charles I give and bequeath in most (to the use of the said Charles) my little Tract of land Containing Fifty Acres more or lefs adjoining the above mentioned Tract to and for the use & benefit of Mary C. & John T. McColough. the children of my doughter Catherine to them Equally & share & share alike, the said Trustee may sell & dispose of the same, if in his opinion it would be to the Interest of the Children to do so, or he may allow their mother to reside on the premises for the purpose of raising her children at his option or discretion.
