three remaining negroes (Subject to Kitty Carpenters Claim as named in my aforesaid will) to be left in trust with Darius Q and Jonathan Browne for the Benefit of Such of their Brothers as have not received an equal part of the property acquired by their mother

having Selected a Spot of ground back of my potatoe patch for a family burrying ground it is my will that when I die I should be buried beside my child allready buried there and that if ever the Land should be Sold that one half acre round Said grave be reserved as Sacred and enviolable and that my grave should be covered over so as to prevent rain falling on it and that my coffin be Laid on Sticks of durable wood to prevent, its touching the ground and pailings kept up round Said grave from time to time at the expense of the Estate
