State aforesaid, Being of sound mind and memory do make and con-  
stitute this my last will and Testament, revokeing all former wills  
that is to Say in the first place that my boddy may be decent-  
ly entered my funeral expences to be paid and all my Just debts  
paid by my Executors herein after named as soon as convenient  
after my decease-- I desire that my Executors herein after nam-  
ed shall sell all my Estate except what shall be herein after  
disposed of and mentioned -- I give and bequeath to William  
Steel and E: B. Benson a negroe Woman named Amey a cow and calf.  
Sow and Piggs. Corn and Meal enough for Amey to live on for  
Twelve months from the time of my death-- I give and bequeath  
to Polly Robbins Ten Acres of land to be laid out for her when  
ever She may choose the Same on the tract of land where on She  
now lives being the land purchased by me from William Steel.  
I desire that my Executors herein after named shall have a  
Cabbin built upon the land which I purchased from W<sup>m</sup> Steel and  
that they have Three acres cleared & fenced and that they per-  
mit the negroe Woman Amey to live there during her lifetime and  
that they permit her the Said negroe Amey to have the use of  
the Cow & Calf Sow and Piggs and their increase during her life  
time and at her death I desire that She may be permitted to  
dispose of the Cow Calf Sow & Piggs and their increase to whom  
ever she may please---- at the death of the negroe Woman Amey  
I then desire that the balance or remainder of the tract of  
land purchased by me from W<sup>m</sup> Steel all except the ten acres

ly entered my funeral expences to be paid by my Executors herein after named as soon as convenient after my decease-- I desire that my Executors herein after named shall sell all my Estate except what shall be herein after disposed of and mentioned -- I give and bequeath to William Steel and E: B. Benson a negroe Woman named Amey a cow and calf Sow and Piggs. Corn and Meal enough for Amey to live on for Twelve months from the time of my death-- I give and bequeath to Polly Robbins Ten Acres of land to be laid out for her when ever She may choose the Same on the tract of land where on She now lives being the land purchased by me from William Steel. I desire that my Executors herein after named shall have a Cabbins built upon the land which I purchased from W<sup>m</sup> Steel and that they have Three acres cleared & fenced and that they permit the negroe Woman Amey to live there during her lifetime and that they permit her the Said negroe Amey to have the use of the Cow & Calf Sow and Piggs and their increase during her lifetime and at her death I desire that She may be permitted to dispose of the Cow Calf Sow & Piggs and their increase to whom ever she may please----- at the death of the negroe Woman Amey I then desire that the balance or remainder of the tract of land purchased by me from W<sup>m</sup> Steel all except the ten acres herein before given to Polly Robbins I give and bequeath to her Son William Jefse Robbins, Should Amey die before the child W<sup>m</sup> Jefse becomes of Age I desire that the land may be rented out for his benefit--

I give and bequeath to Caleb Edmonson one Hundred Dollars in Cash should there be that much left after paying my debts from the proceeds of the Sale of Such property as I have not disposed of - I give and bequeath to James Green Sixty Dollars should there be that much left after Edmonson receives his

Jefse fifty Dollars to purchase a Horse for him which Horse may  
be used by his Mother Polly in tending her Crop that is should  
there be So much left after paying the aforesaid Edmonson and

And to Carry this my last will and testament into effect ac-  
cording to the true intent and meaning thereof I do hereby nom-  
inate Constitute and appoint William Steel and E. B. Benson to  
be my true & Lawful Executors of this my Said last will and tes-  
tament revokeing all former Wills Codicals and bequests Whatever  
In testamony whereof I have hereunto set my hand Seal this Sixth
