The balance of my Tract of land to be bestowed to my Sons Frances A Ragsdale and John F Ragsdale to be Equally divided between them at her death to be divided between them and their heirs forever. It is my desire that my two Sons have all the land my Wife ~~possess~~ hir Death I Wish my Daughter Elizabeth to receive one hundred Dollars as her part of my Estate and Each and Every other Daughter I have to receive Seventy five Dollars to be collected out of my Personal Property (if so much there be) and if any money remains in hands of the Executors after defraying all expense that may be not herein before particularly disposed of I desire may be equally divided amongst my Several Children herein before Named Except my Negro boy Benjamin and my Waggon which I wish my Two boys Frances A Ragsdale and John F. Ragsdale to have and pofsefs And lastly I do
