4<sup>th</sup> I wish that my son Elijah Brown do take the charge of his mother and see to the managing of her business for her and that out of the procedes of the sales of my property she my wife shall be at liberty to remunerate him according to her Judgment for services given If there shall be anything remaining I I wish it equally divided among my legal representativs. I further appoint my son Elijah Brown Executor of this my last will and testament
