GEORGE BROWN

I George Brown of Anderson District though feeble in body yet of a sound disposing mind and memory being desiros to dispose of such estate as God in his providence has blefsed me with do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner following (to wit)

1st I will that if there is not money enough on hand to pay all my just debts and funeral expences that a sufficiency of my personal property at the discretion of my Wife shall be sold and payment made -- --

2 I further wish that all the residue of my estate personall and real shall be pofsefsed and for the use of my dear wife Rachel Brown during her natural life and at any time if necessary she may sell stock or personal property to procure for herself the neces~~ary~~ comforts of life -- --

3rd I wish that after the death of my wife all that may remain of my person and real estate be sold by my Executor hereafter appointed and that One Hundred Dollars be given to my son Isham Brown to ~~equale~~ him with my other sons Jefse Brown and Elijah Brown in the dificet of his land -- --

4th I wish that my son Elijah Brown do take the charge of his mother and see to the managing of her businefs for her and that out of the procedes of the sales of my property she my wife shall be at liberty to remunerate him according to her Judgment for servises given If there shall be anything remaining I I wish it equally divided among my legal representativs I further appoint my son Elijah Brown Executor of this my last will and testament
