ISAAC ELROD

In the name of God Amen

I Isaac Elrod of the District of Anderson in the State of South Carolina beliving it to be my duty to make such disposition of such worley estate as it has pleased God to blefs me with in this life that will be most beneficial to my family after my death and being of Sound mind and memory do make and order that my last will and Testament And first of all I give my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it to me and my body to the Earth in a decent Christian burial and as to my worley Estate I give devise and dispose of the Same in the following manner and form

Item first I give and bequeath to my Son George Elrod the Intrest of Eight hundred Dollars for the suppoarte and main-tainance of my wife Nancy Elrod which the said George Elrod is at my Deth to take hur in his house and take good Cear of hur Duren hur natul life or widderhood the principle Eighte hundred Dollars to Remain in the hands of my Son Adam Elrod and he is to see that George Elrod git the Intrest Annelly my will is that my wife Nancy Shall hav hur bed and furniture and Clothing and Chest & Table that she brought with hur when I married hur to despose of as She sea Cause

Item second At my deth I will that the whole of my Estate both reale and personty be sole on acredit of twelve months and when the money is collected I will that fifty dollars each be paid to my three daughters vs Leviny Sarha and Mary daughters that are deed vs Rachel & Elizabeth *And that fifty dollare be paid to the children of Each of my* But if there are no living isue of Either of my daughers that are deed at my death the money willed to them shall belong to my estate and be Equally devided

my last will and Testament And first of all I give my soul into

are deed vs Rachel & Elizabeth But if there are no living issue
of Either of my daughters that are deed at my death the money
willed to them shall belong to my estate and be Equally divided
among all my children and after fulfilling the above Items in
my will the proseeds of the sale of the whole of my Estate Shall
be Equally divided among all my Children And I do herby consti-
tute make and ordain my son Adam Elrod Executor of this my last
will and testament and do herby disallow and revoke all others
ratifying this and no other to be my last will and testament in
witnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty
thurd day of May in the year of our Lorde one thousand Eighte
