Said Legasys do come to them I, do alow her part to my brother
Jofeph And I alfo Alow if any of my brothers be dead the other
that is liveing to have Both thier Shares I, Do likwife leave un-
to my brother Jofeph all my wearing Clofe And I, do Alow confirm
and ordain this and no other to be my last will and teftament And
I, do likwife Apoint Anonimate & Authorife my True and faith-
full friends James Love and Thomas Hunter to be my whole and
Sole Executors As witnefs Hereunto I, have Interchangeably Set
my hand and Afixed my Seal this twenty Eight day of June and in
The year of our lord one thousand Seven hundred and Ninety four--
1794 --- --- ---
