In the Name of God Amen, I James Wilson of Pendleton County & State of South Carolina, being of Sound and Disposing Mind and Memory, Do make and ordain this my last will & testament in manner and form following (that is to say I give & recommend My soul to Almighty God who gave it And my body to be Decently interred at the Discrefsion of After nam'd Sole Heir & Executrix in full afsurance that my body will raised at the Resurrection, IMPRIMIS, I Give unto My Brother John Wilson, five Shillings Sterking, And also to his Oldest Son Robert Wilson five Shillings like money to be paid by my Executrix -- Imprimis I Ordain and Desire that my Wife Keziah may have the plantation whereon I now live with all my Stock of Horses Cattle Hogs &c, with all my Plantation Utensils Household furniture Books, & papers rights & Credits (out of which she is to pay all my lawfull debts) and Indeed all I have in the world Except what I have above mention'd Lastly I do make and Constitute Keziah My loving wife, Sole Executrix of this my last will & testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Affix'd my Seal this thirteenth day of April 1790, Sign'd Sealed & pronounced, by the said James Wilson in the presence of
