Item 11, I will and bequeath to my wife Mary Harris in fee Simple forever a Negro girl named Phillis, with my bed and furniture and the choice of a milch Cow, also that She have the services of my Megro Woman Sarah during her widdowhood or natural lifetime, then S. woman to revert back to my Children. Item 12, I will that all my just debts be paid out of my Estate previous to the distribution of any of the forgoing legacies. Item 13, I will that whatever property there may be over and above what I have already distributed be equally divided a ong all my Childred. also that my Sons Nathaniel and Joseph act as Trustees for my Wife.

Item 14th I do hereby appoint my Sons Nathaniel, Joseph P. and Benjamine my Executors to this my last will and Testament and that they shall appoint the appraisons to make the distributions as above directed. Witness my hand and Scal this 17th Feb. In the year of our Lord one thousan eight hundred and fortyfive. and Seventieth of American Independent.
