IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN, I, John Johnson of the State of South Carolina in the County of Pendleton; yeoman; Being of a Sound and Disposing mind and memory, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following; That is to say, first, I will that all my debts and Funeral Charges be paid and Discharged by my Executor herein after named Andrew Jones; Also I do give and Bequeath unto my loving wife one Sertain bay mare with her saddle and Bridle two Cows and Calves two Ewes and lambs two sows and pigs with there Increas for the Support of hir; and her Childron Also one feather Bed with its furniture; Also it is my Desire that my negroe boy by name Ben I do give and o hundred acres of land Bequeath Unto my Son Joseph; Likewic Joseph; lying on the Great Sattketch Lying in winton County in orange burgh Destrict Also I do give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth a Track of Land Containing one Hundred Acres Lying on the Three mile Creek being the wawters of the big Sattketchers , Likewise I do give and Bequeath unto my daugter Elizabeth four Cows and Calves and one feather Bead and furniture; Also I do give and Bequeath unto my Son Joseph Eleven Head of Cattle and a Sertain Bone mare and the Rest of my Moovables Estate, LASTLY, I do make and constitute, Andrew Jones my said Executor of this my Last will and Testa_ment.
