I John Linley, of Pendleton County, Yeoman, being of Sound and disposing Mind and Memory, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament, in Maner and Form following--That is to Say, That all the Property whatever of which I Stand Seized and possed, real and perfonal, (except what my Executor and Executrix may judge necefsary to be reServed for the Ufe of my Wife and Children, Such as Bedding and Utenfils ufed in the Houfe) Shall, in Cafe I do not Survive my prefent Sicknefs, be Sold at Public Sale, at the Difcretion of my Executors:---the Produce of which Sale, in the firft Place, I hereby direct to go in Difcharge of all my juft Debts; --and the Refidue of Said Property I hereby bequeath to be equally divided between my Wife, Sarah Linley, and my unmarried Children;--my Said Wife being firft allowed Such a Proportion of Said Property for the Maintenance, Support, and Education of Said Children, as Shall be judged to be juft and equitable by my Said Executor and Executrix. ---Laftly, I do make and conftitute William Pytason and my said Wife, Sarah Linley, Executor and Executrix of this my Laft Will and Testament.
