this 5th of Decemt 1792- and of the soverinity and Indepindincey
of Amirica the seventeenth, make and publish this my last will
and Testament, in Manner following (that is to say) first I give
to my Mother Rachel Smith, the Plantation and Tract of Land where-
on she now ~~lives~~ Containing one Hundred Acres more or less--to
injoy and pofsefs the same During her--Natural life, and after
her death, I divise the same to William Smith, Sun of my Sister
Mary Smith and his heirs forever, Also I give and bequeath to my
Mother affors^d --one bay Mare and othe property, Notes and Book
Book accounts--Also I give to s^d William Smith Sun of Mary^s one
young bay Mare or filley--And I make and Ordain hir my Mother
Affors^d Sole Exicutrix of this my Will, in Trust for the intent
and purpofses, in this my Will Contained--
