Hearston one Hundred Dollars and I also give unto my two nephews Alexander Stephenson of Abiville District and William Stephenson of Anderson District one Hundred Dollars each. all the rest of my estate I desire may be equally devided between my two Brothers John Stephenson and Samuel Stephenson and lastly I do constitute and appoint my friend
