Item I Give and Bequath Unto my Three Sons Mathew Joseph & John Thompson my plantation after that my youngest Son John, arives to the age of Eighteen Years, the Land is to be Valied and Eaquely Divided among the Three; but if my Oldest Son Mathew Shoo,^d Incline to Keep the Whole then heis to Pay Unto Each of the Other Two (Viz) Joseph and John the One Third Part of the Valuation four year after the Said Valuation.- - -

Likewise,. Two Negro Boys (Viz) Bob & Sam. I allow to be Remain with my Wife In Order to afsist hir to Rais my Children and after that my Youngest Son arives to the age of Eighteen I allow the Two Negroes Boys to be Sold and Eaqually Divided among all my Children- - - - -

Likewise;- all my Bond Notes and Other Amounts Which is Due to me I allow them to Collected, and After Paying for the mill- the Remainder if any is to be Equally Divided among all my Children my Wife Recieving and Eaqual Shear of the above, Debts.-----

Likewise Constitute and appoint My Will Beloved wife Marey Thompson With Co^l Robert Anderson to be my Whole and Sole Executors of this My Last Will and Testiments. In Witness Whereof I have
