Secondly z sive and Bequeath to the said William Toney and David

G. Raney in trust for my said daughter Sarah Pope during her natural life a certain Tract of Land in Florida where I formerly lived ajoining the Lands of Col William Toney and others containing one Hundred & sixty acres and after her death, I give and bequeath the said Lands to the hiers of her Body in fee simple forever. And for the better carrying into effect the true intent of the foregoing trust in this & the preceding clause contained the same being hereby declared to be for the sole and entire benefut comfort and support of my said daughter during her life and the hiers of her Body after her decease, the said Trustees are authorised and empowered independently and exclusively to control the same by an annual hire and rent or other disposition of said property for a term of years care being had that the proceeds therefrom shall be had and enjoyed by my said daughter during her life and by the hiers aforesaid after until such time as it may be deemed by them as most conducive to their interest that the same shall be distributed amongst om when they shall have nower and are hereby authorised to diAnderson County Will Book B, 1835-184
