

WILL OF

NATHAN M<sup>C</sup>ALLISTER

In the name of God Amen. I Nathan M<sup>C</sup>Callister of the State of South Carolina & District of Anderson being in feeble health and at advanced age, though of Sound and disposing mind, memory & understanding, calling to mind the uncertainty of the continuance of life and the absolute certainty of death & being desirous to dispose of the wordly effects that it has pleased God to blefs me with, do make constitute & ordain this to be my last will & testament hereby revokeing all other wills by me heretofore made.

First. I give with confiding hope my Soul to God, and my body after my death to be buried in a Christian manner.

2<sup>nd</sup>. I give and bequeath to Nathan M<sup>C</sup>Callister Arnold a child raised by me a certain tract of land whereon David Gordon now lives containg 293 acres more or lefs in fee simple for life.

3<sup>rd</sup>. I give and bequeath to Nathan M<sup>C</sup>Callister son of Andrew M<sup>C</sup>Callister the whole of that tract of land whereon I now live, containg about Seven hundred acres in fee simple forever. on condition he pay to Francis M<sup>C</sup>Callister my brother Five dollars & to his son Nathan M<sup>C</sup>Callister ninety five dollars in one year & a day after his taking pofsefsion of said land, & the said Nathan M<sup>C</sup>Callister, son of Andrew M<sup>C</sup>Callister is immediately after my death to take pofsefsion of this aforesaid premises together with all my personal estate. he is (viz) Nathan M<sup>C</sup>Callister to pay one hundred dollars to be equally divided among the heirs of Andrew M<sup>C</sup>Callister that may be living at the time of my decease also one hundred dollars to Elizabeth Emberson my only living Sister also one hundred dollars to my Brother John M<sup>C</sup>Callister one hundred to Thomas M<sup>C</sup>

pleased God to blefs me with, do make constitute & ordain this to be my last will & testament hereby revokeing all other wills by me heretofore made.

I give and bequeath to Nathan M<sup>c</sup>Callister son of Andrew M<sup>c</sup>Callister the whole of that tract of land whereon I now live, containg about Seven hundred acres in fee simple forever. on condition he pay to Francis M<sup>c</sup>Callister my brother Five dollars & to his son Nathan M<sup>c</sup>Callister ninety five dollars in one year & a day after his taking pofsefsion of said land, & the said Nathan M<sup>c</sup>Callister, son of Andrew M<sup>c</sup>Callister is immediately after my death to take pofsefsion of this aforesaid premises together with all my personal estate. he is (viz) Nathan M<sup>c</sup>Callister to pay one hundred dollars to be equally divided among the heirs of Andrew M<sup>c</sup>Callister that may be living at the time of my decease also one hundred dollars to Elizabeth Emberson my only living Sister also one hundred dollars to my Brother John M<sup>c</sup>Callister one hundred to Thomas M<sup>c</sup>Callister & William M<sup>c</sup>Callister my brothers one hundred to each. also that he pay one hundred dollars to the heirs of Rosa M<sup>c</sup>Callister to be equally divided among them. One hundred dollars to be paid to Allen Arnold all those legacies to be paid by the aforementioned Nathan M<sup>c</sup>Callister I do constitute and appoint the said Nathan M<sup>c</sup>Callister and John M<sup>c</sup>Callister executors of this my last will & testament and they charged & enjoined to pay all my just debts & faithfully execute this my last

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the tenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six and in the Sixtieth year of American Independence.
