Imprimis.-- I Give and bequeath My Soul to God Who gave it and my body to the Dust to be Decently Buried at the Expence of my Estate-- Hoping at the resurrection to receive the purchased reward- When my Soul & body Shall be reunited & See Corruption & Separation No More-- --

Item 1<sup>st</sup> - I Will & allow that all the Debts due by me be Carefully & honestly paid- and the remainder of the Estate of which I may be possessed ~~to be~~ to be Exposed to public Vendue and the proceeds thereof I by this Last Will & testament Dispose of in the Following Manner -- ---

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I Give and bequeath to my beloved wife Milly Junkin one third part of my Estate -----

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I Will that the remaining Balance of my Estate be Equally Divided among my Five children Mary Jane- Margaret- Elizabeth- Westley and William Without Distinction Share & Share Alike--- and Lastly--I do hereby make, ordain, constitute & appoint my Friends Jefse Dobbins & E. S. Norris Executors of this my Last Will & testament Desiring them to Execute the same according to the true intent and meaning hereof. & hereby revoking & disannulling all other Wills or testaments by me heretofore made. Establishing this only to be my Last Will & testament Signed with my
