After payment of my debts and funeral expenses I give to my wife Nancy all of the residue of my estate as well real as personal for and during the term of her natural life, And after her decease I give Andrew & Juda to my son John Harper Also I desire that my son John Harper take Mary and her increase if any she has at their or her appraisment retaining an equal share (with the resof the legates) of the same in his own hands, I give the balance of my estate to all of my children the same to be sold and equally divided among them all or their heirs as the case may be, forever.

And lastly, I do constitute and appoint my said wife executrix and my son John Harper executor of this my last will and testament, by me heretofore made In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this nineteenth day of August
