Secondly -- It is my Will and desire that my Executors as soon as they can lawfully shall dispose of my Estate Real and personal to the highest bidders at the usual credit. And it is my will and desire that the Loney raised from my Estate after all just demands have been paid shall be appropriated to the Support of my wife, excepting the Sum of one dollar to each of my Children or in Case of the decease of any of them to the legal representative of Said deceased. And my desire is that my Executors shall pay to my wife from time to time as soon as they shall have collected the money arising from the Sale of my Estate as much money as will be necefsary for Supporting her in comfort. I do hereby point David Rufsell and Revd John Vandiver Executors of this . my Will and Testament and I do hereby declare this to be my Will
