 Earth to be buried in a decent and Christain Like manner at
 the Discretion of my Executors here after Named nothing Doubt-
 ing but at the general Resurrection I Shal receivit the same
 by the mighty power of God am as tuching Such worldly Estate
 where with it hath pleased god to blefs me with in this life
 I give despose and Bequeath of the Same in the following man-
 ner and forme-----

Item first I give and bequeath to Ann Stivender my dearly be-
 loved wife four Negroes Samed as Follows Will Jo Betty and
 tepny with all my Stock of horses Cattle and hogs with all
 my Household furniture in full goods and moveable Effects
 during her life time and at her Decease to be Equally Divided
 between Every Child I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
 Ann Stivender half of the mills both Saw mill and Grifs mill
 with all my lands during her Life Time and after her Decease
 the hole of the mills and Lands to be lifts to Aveirhart
 Stivender James but Fedewick Stivender and William McClendle
 is to have there Dower of the mills Agreeble to there writ-
 ings Also all the Lands that I have given to my Children Is
 not to be sole out of the family but to be intale and remain
 in the family To my Son John Stivender I give and bequeath

ings Also all the Lands that I have given to my Children is
not to be sole out of the family but to be intale and remain
in the family To my Son John Stivender I give and bequeath
fifty Dollars to be paid after the Decease of my wife as Soon
as it can be raised out of the mills not to be raised out of
the moveble property Item I give and bequeath to Barbara
McClenele forty Dollars to be paid after the Death of my wife
as Seen as it Can be raised out of the mills-- Item I give
and bequeath to my Daughter Mance Zorn forty Dollars to be

paid after the Death of my wife as Soon as ti can be raised out of the mills- Item I give and bequeath Ti Margaret Stivender forty Dollars to be paid after the Death of my wife as Soon as It Can be Raised out of the mills- Item I give and bequeath to Catherine Stivender ofrty Dollars to be paid after the Death of my wife as Soones it Can be Raised out of the mills--I Likewise ordain and appoint my loving wife Ann Stivender and Fredwick Stivender my Son Soley my Exeterbricks and Exeeters of this My Last will and testament all and Singular my Lands tenaments and Mefouages by them finmly to be possesfed and Ingoyd and I do here by utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and Every other Testament and wills legases and Exetors by me in any will made Confirming this and No other to be my last will and testament in witness whereof I have here unto Set my hand and Seal this twenty first Day of April one thousand Eight hundred and Six Signed Sealed and published pronounced

and I declard to be his last will and testament
