That is to say, I give and bequeath to my loving daughter Susanna Cynthia Brown and the heirs of her Body, all my Worldly Estate both real and personal; Provided Nevertheless, if my said daughter Susanna Cyntha Brown, should happen to die, without living Ifsue of her Body; then and in that Case, all my said Estate both personal and real, to return to the nearest heirs of my Body, by my Mothers Lineage; in witness whereof I have hereunte set my hand and Seal this twenty seventh day of July in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and Ninety eight, and in the twenty third year of the Indepen-
